- Advanced technical skills training

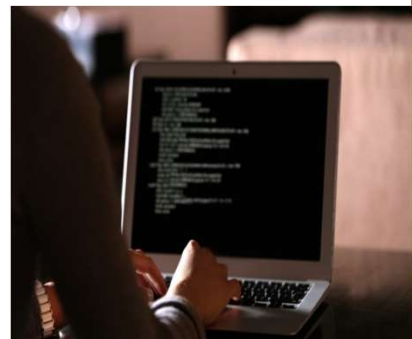
#### Who is Eligible?
